有關校園開放時間、午膳安排及派發快速檢測包等安排

根據教育局指引，本校各級將於2022年5月3日(星期二)起恢復面授課堂，請 貴家長留意於恢復面授課堂後，校園內的各項安排：

(一) 早上校園入口開放時間：

星期一至五 --- 上午 7 時 30 分

星期六 --- 上午 8 時正

(二) 中四及中五級午膳安排：

如中四至中五級學生已完成接種第二劑 2019 冠狀病毒疫苗並超過十四天，將於逢星期二下午留校參與實體形式的聯課活動。學生可選擇外出午膳，唯學生用膳時必須遵守《預防及控制疾病條例》下的社交距離措施及其他衛生防疫措施。學生亦可選擇在校內指定地點午膳，並遵守校內午膳的守則。如學生自備飯盒，可於早上(第一個小息前)將飯盒交到校務處，由校務處代為擺放在雪櫃儲存，並於午飯時間前安排用電蒸櫃翻熱飯盒。

本校致力推動環境保護，於本年度獲環境及自然保育基金資助購置及安裝兩個雪櫃、一個電蒸櫃(用作翻熱午膳)及一個消毒機(用作消毒及保存已清洗的可重用食物容器)，供學生使用，藉以推廣校園「走塑」風氣。

(三) 派發快速抗原測試包予學生：

於恢復面授課堂後，學生在每天早上在家中完成一次快速抗原測試，獲得陰性結果後才能進入校園上課或參與其他學習活動。教育局考慮到有經濟需要家庭的情況，故已將免費的快速抗原測試(快測包)送抵學校，並分派予合資格的學生，另外，本校亦獲得善長捐贈若干數量的快測包供學生使用。因此，由 5 月 3 日起，本校將安排於每星期的最後一天上課日，向學生派發相當於下星期使用量的快測包予所有學生。

Dear Parents/Guardians,

School Hours, Lunch Arrangements and Distribution of RAT Test Kits

In accordance with the Education Bureau's instructions, the school will resume face-to-face classes on 3 May 2022. Kindly please pay attention to the following arrangements after the resumption of face-to-face classes:

- (1) Entrances of the school campus will be open for students in the morning at the following hours. No student should be on campus before the opening time.

Monday to Friday --- 7:30 a.m.

Saturday --- 8:00 a.m.

- (2) Lunch arrangements for S4 and S5 students:

For S4 and S5 students who have received the second dose of vaccination for more than 14 days, they should stay at school after the morning session and attend face-to-face Afternoon OLE activities on Tuesday. Students may eat out during lunch break, but they should strictly observe the social distancing measures and other health precautionary measures as stipulated in the Prevention and Control of Disease Ordinance. Students may also opt to have luncheons at school in designated areas, and observe the school regulations for having meals at school. If students bring their own lunch to school, they may leave their lunch boxes at the General Office in the morning (before the first recess). The staff of the General Office will arrange to have their lunch boxes refrigerated and then reheated before lunch break.

The school is dedicated to promoting environmental protection. In this academic year, we are delighted to have received funding from the "Environment and Conservation Fund" for purchasing and installing two refrigerators, one steam cabinet (for reheating the lunch) and one disinfection machine (for disinfecting and storing the washed reusable food containers). All items of the aforementioned catering equipment have already been installed and are currently in operation. Students are encouraged to make good use of the equipment and help promoting "Plastic-free" school lunch.

- (3) Distribution of "Rapid Antigen Test" (RAT) test kits:

After the resumption of face-to-face classes, every student has to complete a COVID-19 RAT at home each day before returning to school. RATs should be conducted in the morning and only students obtaining negative results are allowed to return to school for lessons. In view of the financial situations of some families, the Education Bureau delivered to the school complimentary RAT test kits for distributing to needy students. In addition, the school has received donations of RAT test kits from individuals and corporates. Hence, starting from 3 May 2022, on the last school day of each week, the school will distribute enough quantity of test kits to students for doing RATs the following week, while stocks last.
