中六級學生家長/監護人：

2023 年香港中學文憑考試中六級校本評核(SBA)呈交分數要求及安排

在新高中學制下，校本評核已於大部份的高中科目中推行，並成為評核學生成績的其中一個重要部分。校本評核是指在學校進行，由任課教師評分的評核活動，分數計算入學生的公開評核成績內，而學校需於指定時段內向香港考試及評核局(考評局)呈交學生的 SBA 分數。

貴子弟將於 2023 年應考香港中學文憑考試，但 2019 冠狀病毒病疫情嚴重影響日常學校運作，因此，考評局與教育局已就 2023 年度文憑試相關甲類科目的評核大綱已透過一次性的應變安排措施作出相應修訂，以精簡公開考試及校本評核部分。以下是本校中六級學生需在 2023 年香港中學文憑考試中呈交 SBA 分數的科目時間表及要求。

Dear Parents/Guardians,

School-based Assessment (SBA) Requirements and Submission Schedule for the 2023 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination

School-based Assessment is an assessment administered in schools as part of the learning and teaching process, with students being assessed by their subject teachers. The main rationale for SBA is to enhance the validity of the public assessment and extend it to include a variety of learning outcomes that cannot be assessed easily through public examinations. SBA marks awarded will be counted towards students' results in the HKDSE Examination. Schools are required to submit these SBA marks according to the submission schedules set by the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA).

Your child is going to sit the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) examination in 2023. However, the outbreak of COVID-19 has severely disrupted normal school operation in the recent school years. In this connection, the Assessment Frameworks of respective Category A subjects have been changed as a result of the implementation of one-off contingency measures to streamline the public examination and SBA for the 2023 HKDSE.

The following is the submission requirements and schedule for the subjects for **2023 HKDSE** taken by our S6 students.

The six sets should consist of two high, two medium and two low levels of performance, to be chosen by the school. As the SBA component is generally worth 10% to 15% (except for Visual Arts) of the total subject mark in the HKDSE examination, please encourage your child to take part in the related learning and assessment activities and urge him/her to complete the assessment tasks on time. *Please note that subject teachers will set an earlier completion date for the assessment activities so that students' SBA marks can be submitted on schedule to the HKEAA by the School.* For details of individual subjects' SBA requirements, you are welcome to consult your child's subject teachers directly.
